

Connected to major freight hubs via regular intermodal service from CN, CPKC and container on barge service from Seacor.









STRATEGIC FOCUS ON GREENING THE SUPPLY CHAIN



Ingram container on barge service: Reduced 9.7 million kg in CO2 emissions and saved 1 million gallons of diesel fuel.



Port NOLA Clean TRIP: Helped replace nearly 100 trucks with cleaner burning engines to improve air quality.



Idle reduction program: Implemented in 2016 to reduce GHG, air pollutants and noise from vehicles, equipment and locomotives.



EPA-classified Tier 1 locomotives: NOPB has 10 in their fleet; deployed 45 solar power switches across its network.
